An Associate Professor of Science Education, Bec is an Iowa native who grew up on a small farm in northeast Iowa (Waukon) where he acquired his love for living things (biophilia). He has been involved with exotic animal husbandry for as long as he can remember, raising snakes, lizards, poison dart frogs, turtles, tortoises, and seramas (miniature chickens) on Wartburg's campus and often in his classroom. He has just returned from the Amazon rainforest (May 11) where he took students to explore nature in South America.
